Foster Friess lived life to the fullest. Unmatched determination drove him to great professional accomplishment. Faith and a passionately generous soul led him to help "the least of these" virtually everywhere his travels took him.

The career that Foster built after he and his wife, Lynn, founded Friess Associates in 1974 won Foster recognition on CNBC as "one of the last century's great investors."
